

Music in Upper Primary

There are lots of music clubs in the Upper Primary at Saltus. Many of our students manage to participate in at least one, if not several of our clubs.

Mrs. Friesen is helping with clubs at the Upper Primary this year. She is running the three's recorder club during Mondays at lunchtime and she also comes on Tuesday at lunch to do the 3's and 4's choir.

Mrs. Fox has a year 5 and 6 recorder club on Wednesday morning from 8:00 to 8:30 and a year 4 recorder club on Thursday morning at the same time. The Upper Primary orchestra practices on Friday mornings from 7:45-8:30 and this group includes years 4 through 7. The 5&6 Choir practices on Friday morning from 8:45 - 9:15.

Mrs. Maule and Mr. Roach do a great job with the Windband, which involves students from year 4-7 and they can be found practicing on Tuesday mornings from 7:50 - 8:30. They also teach many of our Upper Primary students privately and do sectionals.

Many students volunteer to play their instruments for morning assemblies or for special concerts. Our choirs and recorder groups have participated in the St. George's Christmas Walkabout, at Windsor Place, at the Agricultural Exhibition, as well as at other functions. Mrs. Maule and Mr. Roach have taken the Windband to perform at Harbour Nights. Students enjoy being involved in Christmas concerts and the end of the year concert as well as Carols For All and the Three Department Concert. Last year the 6's and 7's had special end of the year performances.
